Application form instructions

According to the regulations for the transport of dangerous goods (GGVSEB, GGVSsee, ADR, UN Recommendations), BAM has been designated as the competent authority in Germany to carry out the necessary assignments of class 1 goods to a division of class 1. Furthermore, the Explosives Law stipulates that for the storage of explosives and articles containing explosives, an official assignment of BAM to a storage group and compatibility group must be available. We would like to draw your attention to the fact that BAM is obliged to publish a list of the classifications, which contains following information about the assignment: notification number, identification of the substance or object, storage group and compatibility group as well as safety-relevant packaging features. In the case of fireworks articles, the identification of the item usually includes the article number and the registration number. The list is published on the BAM website as an official notice.

To make it easier for you to submit your application to BAM and for us to process it, we would like to ask you to consider the following points when filling out the form overleaf. The numbers in the explanation correspond to the numbers in the application form.

A note in advance: Please use the abbreviation (i. e.: **TLFW, TLST or TLEX**) in the subject line of all e-mails, so that your message can be quickly assigned to the correct area!

1. The information on the **applicant** must include at least the following:
Company name and full postal address. The applicant does not have to be identical to the manufacturer of the product.
2. **Delivery address for the notice:** Enter only if the applicant wishes the **notice** to be sent to a different address.
3. **Cost debtor:** In the event that the costs incurred for the processing of the application are not borne by the applicant him-/herself but by another party liable to pay the costs, we require all the information listed under point 1. as well as his/her written declaration of consent to bear the costs.
4. **VAT-ID:** The VAT identification number of the cost debtor must be indicated here.
5. **Application content:** Please select one or more sub-items you wish to apply for.
6. **Technical name:** Please give a clear name of the explosive substances or articles as they should be mentioned in the notice. This is usually the trade name, which can also be found, for example, in the EU type-examination certificate (or approval, exemption permit, clearance certificate, or similar).

Application fireworks: If the application contains more than one article or item, **the attachment "Fireworks"** must be used additionally and submitted with the application in digital form. Please follow further instructions that are listed in the attachment. The reference to a list or attachment must then be selected as the name.

7. **Identification elements:** Additional marking of the explosive substances or articles (e.g. **registration no., article no., EU type-examination certificate no., container-nr.** etc.) must be indicated here. This is particularly necessary if the technical name alone does not allow a clear identification of the classification article, e. g. if it contains a collective term. If necessary, these articles are to be listed with references and technical data in the annex "Fireworks".
8. **Packaging:** The classification is only given in connection with the selected packaging. In some cases, specially designed packaging is used to specifically reduce the hazardous effects outside the package. In this case, please provide all necessary packaging details. Especially when using the packaging method P101, please attach a description and a drawing including the drawing number.
9. **Proposed assignment:** It is helpful if you can already indicate a desired classification based on similar articles already classified or other sources of information. You may propose a hazard division (e.g. 1.1, 1.2, 1.3, 1.4) and the corresponding compatibility group (please note: for storage groups the class 9 does not exist; use 1.4S instead). You may only select **one classification**; in case you have items requiring more than one classification code you are kindly requested to use separate application forms.

UN No: The intended use must be clear from the technical documentation, as this will determine the UN number and technical name to be applied. You can enter the UN number that applies in your view.

10. **Contact person:** To clarify any open questions, please name a contact person with an e-mail and telephone number.

Please include all other information that may support the processing (e. g. test results from other institutions, explanations of technical names, and identification features) in your e-mail or letter.

The costs for processing your application will be charged to you following the Cost Ordinance for Measures in the Transportation of Dangerous Goods (GGKostV) or the BAM special Regulation on Fees (BAMBGebV).
